



General Terms and Conditions for Registration for the Swiss Congress of Radiology 2025 (SCR'25)

1.1 These General Terms and Conditions stipulate the regulations for registration for SCR'25, hosted by Swiss Radiological Conventions Ltd., a limited company according to Swiss Law (hereinafter referred to as "SRC").

1.2 A contractual relationship subject to these terms and conditions is entered into between the SRC and the participant of the SCR'25 (hereinafter referred to as "participant").

1.3 Any contractual or legal declarations of the participant of SCR'25 or a third party deviating from these General Terms and Conditions shall not be part of the contract entered into with the SRC, notwithstanding the consumption of the services offered by the participant and the payment of fees therefore.

1. Registration

2.1 Registration for SCR'25 is to be made electronically by using the respective registration tool provided on the SCR'25 homepage (www.myscr.ch). Registrations without participant's full name, complete e-mail, postal address and date of birth cannot be processed. It is the participant's own responsibility to provide all necessary details and documents and to ensure the completeness of registration.

2.2 Upon registration on behalf of third persons, the registering person warrants and guarantees to be entitled to execute such registrations according to these General Terms and Conditions in the name and on behalf of such third persons by proxy and to declare any and all approvals and consents required according to these General Terms and Conditions in the third person's name and behalf.

2.3 Upon registration the participant shall receive an e-mail confirming registration for verification of the participant's personal data only.



- 2.4 The participant's registration for SCR'25 shall not become effective until the SRC has received the full due registration fee.
- 2.5 Payment of the registration fee can be made either by bank transfer or by credit card (VISA or MasterCard/EuroCard).
- 2.6 Upon payment of the registration fee by credit card the participant will receive a confirmation e-mail. An invoice for the registration fee will be available in a secure area accessible via the SCR'25 homepage.
- 2.7 If bank transfer is the chosen method of payment for registration, the recipient will receive a confirmation of registration by e-mail upon completion of registration. Both the confirmation of order and the invoice for the registration fee will be available in a secure area accessible via the SCR'25 homepage.

The recipient's name and Personal ID must be provided as a reference on the bank transfer document. Any bank charges incurred are to be paid by the participant. Payment via bank transfer has to be finalised within 10 working days so that the registration is finalised. This in turn does not extend applicable deadlines.

- 2.8 Payment by cheque is not accepted.
- 2.9 Registration to SCR'25 is non-transferable. New registration and payment are required.



2.10 Name changes are not possible. New registration and payment are required.

2.11 Unless mandatory law providing otherwise, SRC will not refund any registration fees once registration and payment have been completed, including in cases of special offers or membership-related changes.

3 Cancellation

3.1 Cancellation by participants

SRC will not refund any registration fees once registration and payment have been completed.

3.2 Cancellation by SRC

In case the safety and well-being of industry partners and congress participants cannot be ensured, or should it appear that organizing the Swiss Congress of Radiology as an onsite event is excessively difficult, and the SRC AG decides to cancel the event, there will be no refund. However, 70% of the payment done will be kept as a credit for the participant to use for his registration for the next Swiss Congress of Radiology.

3.3 Cancellation due to Force Majeure or events beyond the control of SRC

In the event that it is judged advisable or necessary to cancel or postpone SCR'25 due to events beyond the control of SRC (e.g. force majeure, blackout, strikes, natural disasters, epidemics, pandemics (Covid 19 or other), government regulations, internet failure or hacker attack, etc.), SRC shall not be obliged to any refund.

3.4 If, for any reason, including but not limited to government regulations, access to the congress centre is limited to a certain number of persons, only the number of persons permitted shall be granted access to the congress centre. Upon the permitted number of persons being reached, SRC shall have the right to deny access to further participants. Not being granted access to the congress centre shall not entitle the participant to any refund of participation fee already paid.



4 Limitation of liability

There is neither any liability nor any obligation of SRC in case of cancellation of SCR'25 for whatever reasons. The liability of SRC for damages of any other kind shall be restricted to wilful intent or gross negligence. The SRC shall not be liable for any damages caused by force majeure.

5 Registration Fees

5.1 Registration fees shall be determined by the registration category. All registration fees for SCR'25 (excluding Society evening tickets) are net of VAT.

5.2 All registration fees can be found on the congress homepage (www.myscr.ch).

5.3 The respective registration fees shall only be valid if registration is submitted and full payment is received by the SRC as at the respective deadline. Failure to meet the relevant deadline will render the relevant invoice document invalid, no congress access will be provided and no confirmation of payment will be issued.

5.4 To attend SCR'25 as SGR-SSR member, SGNM-SSMN member, SVMTR-ASTRM member, SSRMP member, or member of any other participating society, membership fees with the respective society must be settled. To benefit from the SGR-SSR member fee, membership for the year 2025 must be settled and approved prior to the participant's registration.

5.5 Resident Registration

Residents have to send a letter by e-mail to registration@radiologiekongress.ch from their head of department confirming their status as resident no later than 5 days after online registration. This document has to be signed by the head of department and written on official hospital letterhead. If this confirmation is not received, the registration fee will be automatically adjusted to a regular fee.



To register on-site as resident, a confirmation, which has to be signed by the head of department and written on official hospital letterhead, must be presented at the registration desk.

5.6 Student Registration

Students under the age of 28 without an academic title can register for free. They have to send a copy of their valid student ID card by e-mail to registration@radiologiekongress.ch no later than 5 days after online registration.

To register on-site as student, the valid student ID card must be presented at the registration desk.

6. Badges and Safety

6.1 The safety of all congress delegates and participants is of utmost importance to the SRC. Security measures and precautions at the SCR'25 congress venue will be tightened to ensure maximum security for all attendees. Badges must be worn visibly on the congress grounds at all times. The SRC reserves the right for staff to check participants' identification upon admission to and/or inside the congress venue. Participants may at any time be requested to present adequate proof of identity. Documents for the proof of identity must include a photograph and signature.

6.2 The congress badge may only be used by the person stated on the badge and cannot be assigned to third persons.

6.3 Participants accept and agree to follow the safety measures conducted by SRC in accordance with the applicable regulations of the Swiss government and other authority, as well as any measure that SRC sees as necessary and may establish to ensure the safety of the participants.

6.4 Participants accept that besides all security measures that will be taken, neither SRC, nor its organisation, the course venue or any other involved organising party can take the responsibility in case of an infection with covid-19 during their travel and stay on occasion of the SCR'25, as well as during the attendance of the event itself.



6.5 The SRC reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone.

6.6 In order to avoid the spread of COVID-19, SCR shall be entitled to restrict access to the congress centre as well as to any other premises where events in the course of SCR'25 shall be held to persons fully and duly vaccinated against COVID-19. The respective requirements to prove such vaccination may be subject to government regulations and will be published in due time on the SCR website. SCR shall be entitled to request the upload of a certificate of vaccination against COVID-19 upon registration and to restrict participation of those not having uploaded such certificate of vaccination.

7. Congress Material

The congress material (badges, etc.) will either be sent to the participant in advance or will be made available to the participant on-site.

8. Certificate of Attendance/CME Accreditation

Any confirmation or certification related to SCR'25 shall be made available within a few days to the participants after each event. Confirmation or certificate of attendance will be made available to the participants as soon as possible, within a few weeks. Only persons who are authorized for CME accreditation will receive the CME confirmation. However, only credits corresponding to actual participation can be claimed by participants for their continuing education, even if the certificate issued by SCR indicates the total number of credits for the whole congress.

9. Warranty and Liability

9.1 SCR'25 and all information, content and materials and other services included or otherwise made available to the participant in the course of SCR'25 are provided by SRC on an "as is" and "as available" basis. SRC makes no representations or warranties of any kind, express or implied, as to the operation of SCR'25, or the information, content, materials or other services included or otherwise made available to the participant through SCR'25 services.



9.2 To the full extent permissible by law, SRC disclaims all warranties, express or implied, including, but not limited to, implied warranties of fitness for a particular purpose. SRC does not warrant that the SCR'25 services, information, content, materials or other services included or otherwise made available to the participant through the SCR'25 services, SRC's servers or electronic communications sent from SRC are free of viruses or other harmful components. To the full extent permissible by law, SRC will not be liable for any damages of any kind arising from the use of any SRC service, or from any information, content, materials or other services included or otherwise made available to the participant through any SRC service.

10. Personal data

Participants are entitled to revoke their consent to the specific data processing at any time by contacting the SCR Office.

11. Industry session attendance / lead retrieval system

Your badge is your business card. SCR and its sponsors are using a lead retrieval system during the congress. Participation at any session might be monitored and tracked using this lead retrieval system. Attendees of any session organised by industry or co-organised by SRC and one or more industry partners agree that their registration details (first name, last name, institution/company, city, country, academic title, salutation, department, address and postal code) will be forwarded to the companies organising the session. Participants therefore consent to the data being passed on and processed by the industry partners. The industry partner becomes the responsible data controller as of this date. The industry partner is obliged to process the participants' data exclusively for the purpose of establishing contact and in compliance with data protection regulations.

12. Filming and photography

We would like to inform you that there may be filming and photography during the SCR. A photo gallery with all photos taken during the congress may be available to registered participants on the SCR website. In addition, photographs taken during the congress may be used for the society's social media channels.



13. Society Evening(s)

SCR may organize one or more evening events on the occasion of the SCR'25. Tickets are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis. Please note that purchased tickets will not be refunded. Tickets will be handed out at the registration desk.

SCR may not accept liability for personal injury, loss/damage to property, personal or otherwise belongings of participants and/or accompanying persons, either during or as a result of any society evening.

14. Applicable Law/Place of Jurisdiction

Any contractual relationship with the SRC shall be subject to Swiss law. The place of jurisdiction shall be Lucerne. The SRC shall also be entitled to pursue any claim before the courts of law competent for the defendant's domicile or general residence.
